


When it's hot outside, your nest box makes a difference.

Did you know that eggs and hatchlings can perish in birdhouse temperatures around 105° Fahrenheit? Studies also show that dark-colored birdhouses can be 15° hotter than more reflective structures. Beyond looking great for many years, that's why we build our nest boxes from 3/4-inch-thick, light-colored, cellular PVC.

Compared to an identically constructed wooden house, this graph demonstrates that our cellular PVC nest box stayed cooler—even during the hottest times of the day.



Tests were performed in full sunlight using calibrated Bluetooth sensors which recorded interior nest box temperatures at one-minute intervals. Screens were placed over entrance holes to prevent potential bird interference.
